2009 Spring Cleanup

April 22nd through the 25th

(Wednesday through Saturday. No Sunday drop-off this year)

At the Gaunt Rd., "Stroud Township Maintenance Yard"

Stroud Township offers residents a 4 day clean-up in which they are invited to bring unwanted junk and clutter from their properties to our **Gaunt Road** Township Maintenance Yard, located ½ mile north of the Stroud Mall on Rt. 611. Accepted items are: furniture, car batteries, automotive waste oil, car tires, appliances and yard waste (brush, leaves, clippings).

PROOF OF RESIDENCY is REQUIRED.....

Typical Fees: Car Load \$5

Mini-van load \$10

Utility Van or Pick-up truck load \$20

Utility trailer load (single axle) \$50

Utility trailer load (tandem axle) \$75

Dual wheel truck load \$75

Tires: Car \$5 each, Truck (20" or larger) \$10 each

Appliances requiring freon removal are \$20 each

NO FEE:

*If you are only bringing the following items, there is **no fee**: car batteries, waste oil, yard waste, branches, brush, grass clippings.* No charge for computers, fax machines, scanners, keyboards & mice, main frames, VCRs, stereos, monitors, printers, telecommunications equipment, speakers, wire, televisions, DVD players.

Materials NOT accepted:

No hazardous materials such as paint solvents or thinners, paint cans with contents, pesticides, herbicides, or chemicals will be accepted. (Monroe County Waste Management (570-643-6100) is working on ways to dispose of these items. No construction debris.)

Also not accepted: automobiles, dirt, cement, loose nails or screws. **NO CONTRACTOR'S REFUSE!**

Yard Waste & Compost Facility: Stroud Township operates a Yard Waste Compost Facility at our Gaunt Road Maintenance Building located off Route 611 one half mile north of Stroud Mall. Residents may bring leaves, grass clippings, tree branches, limbs and brush to the facility for chipping and composting. Compost and garden mulch is made at this location and is available free to township residents when available. Township employees are available to load pick-up trucks and small trailers during our annual Spring Clean-up.
